



A popular fly in the Southern Appalachians, as well as Arkansas.. Easy and fun fly that will be effective in your fly box.

Materials

Hook: #12 Mustad 3906 Thread: Black 6/0 Body: Red Dubbing Ribbing: Peacock Herl Head Cement or similar



July 27, 7 PM Stealth Bomber – Lead Tyer, Connor Baker

Cost: \$2.00 in person

A good Southeastern warm water pattern invented by Georgia fishing guide, Kent Edmonds. This is a topwater fly, designed to get the attention of bass by stirring up the water and making a lot of bubbles.

<u>Globug</u>

Hook: Gamakatsu B10S various sizes Tail: Bucktail Flash: Pearl Flashabou Foam: 2 mm foam Body: Cactus Chenille Legs: Barred rubber legs Thread: 210 denier (white, or whatever color you have)







Instead of swordfish, two North Carolina anglers reel in a rare species



A few friends from North Carolina spent the day doing some off shore fishing. They were approximately 60 miles off the coast from the fishing town of Morehead. With their lines rigged up with squid, they were targeting swordfish. Eventually when brining in their line, they realized they had a fish on! However, this was not the behemoth swordfish they hoped for, but a bigscale pomfret.

Weighing only 26 pounds 11 ounces, this fish is quite a bit smaller than even a small swordfish. However, what makes this fish unique is the rarity of it. Caught sometimes in Florida, this is the first recorded instance of this fish being caught in North Carolina. Below are some pictures of this prehistoric looking fish!
